Board Posting Rule Enjoined By Federal Appeals Court This Morning

As a follow-up to our Client Alert of this morning, earlier today the Federal D.C. Court of Appeals granted the U.S. Chamber of Commerce's motion to enjoin the National Labor Relations Board from implementing its posting rule pending its decision.

This means that employers **<u>DO NOT</u>** have to put up the Board's posting on April 30. The Court set an expedited briefing scheduled which sets September for a hearing. As a result, there likely will not be a decision until fall at the earliest. We will keep you apprised of any further developments.
